Data Category Code separates the data by the categories specified by the request:

- 1. For every school year between 2012 to 2021, separated into the following categories:
 - a. All students
 - b. Indigenous students
 - c. Students with a verified EAP disability
 - d. Students living in out of home care
 - e. Indigenous students with a verified EAP disability
 - f. Indigenous students living in out of home care
 - g. Students with a verified EAP disability living in out of home care
 - h. Indigenous students with a verified EAP disability living in out of home care
- 2. For every school year between 2016 to 2021, separated into the following categories:
 - a. Students with a disability registered with the NCCD
 - b. Indigenous students with a disability registered with the NCCD
 - c. Students with a disability registered with the NCCD living in out of home care
 - d. Indigenous students with a disability registered with the NCCD living in out of home care

- 3. For the school year 2019, separated into the following categories:
 - a. Students with a verified EAP disability by category of disability:
 - i. Physical disability
 - ii. Intellectual disability
 - iii. Autism Spectrum Disorder
 - iv. Hearing/Vision Impairment
 - v. Speech-Language Impairment.
 - b. Students with a disability registered with the NCCD by adjustment category:
 - i. Physical
 - ii. Cognitive
 - iii. Sensory
 - iv. Social/Emotional

Notes

- 2021 SDA was not yet available for reporting at the time this report was prepared (28/01/2022).
- 2. The word Indigenous in this document refers to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people of Australia.
- 3. Student counts are distinct counts of all full-time and part-time students at each school in Prep to Year 12.
- 4. Counts are individual students within each grouping, column sums may exceed totals.
- School Disciplinary Absence (SDA) student counts are the counts of distinct students who have received at least one SDA type. A student who received more than one type of SDA may be counted under multiple SDA types.
- EAP disability data is available from 2015 onwards. A student with an EAP disability is a student with an active OneSchool
 record in the February and August enrolment collections each year and one or more active verified disabilities. Students
 may receive SDAs under multiple EAP <u>disability</u> categories.
- A count of NCCD students is the number of students with disability receiving adjustments to access and participate in
 education according to the Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability (NCCD). The data is
 collected from schools annually in August. The NCCD SDA counts in this report are adjusted for students with conflicting
 NCCD records.
- 8. SDAs were impacted by the COVID-19 health pandemic in 2020.

School Disciplinary Absences (SDAs)

- a. There are four categories of SDA: Short Suspension (1 to 10 days), Long Suspension (11 to 20 days), Exclusion and Cancellation.
- b. A student may be suspended from school on the following grounds
- disobedience
- misbehaviour
- conduct that adversely affects, or is likely to adversely affect, other students
- conduct that adversely affects, or is likely to adversely affect, the good order and management of the school
- the student's attendance at the school poses an unacceptable risk to the safety or wellbeing of other students or of staff
- the student is charged with a serious offence, refer to Suspension (charge-related)
- the student is charged with an offence other than a serious offence and the principal is reasonably satisfied it would not
 be in the best interests of other students or of staff for the student to attend the school while the charge is pending, refer
 to Suspension (charge-related).
- c. A student may be excluded from school on the following grounds
- persistent disobedience
- misbehaviour

- conduct that adversely affects, or is likely to adversely affect, other students
- conduct that adversely affects, or is likely to adversely affect, the good order and management of the school
- · the student's attendance at the school poses an unacceptable risk to the safety or wellbeing of other students or of staff
- if suspension of the student is inadequate to deal with the disobedience, misbehaviour, conduct or risk.
- d. A principal may cancel the enrolment of a student if the behaviour of a student (who is older than compulsory school age) amounts to a refusal to participate in the educational program provided at the school.
- e. Applicable from 2014, the length of suspensions has been revised. Short Suspensions, previously of a length of 1-5 days, are now 1-10 days. Long Suspensions, previously 6-20 days, are now 11-20 days. The length of the suspension is reflected in the SDA Description field, while the SDA Type field retains the original Short/Long distinction for times series comparisons. However, due to the time series break, caution should be used when comparing suspension data prior to 2014 with suspension data from 2014 onward.
